Get Hired: Powerful Words Make Your Resume Great

What are power words? These are words designed to capture the reader's attention, demonstrate your strengths, and highlight the reasons why you are right for the job.

The most commonly used words are:

Led...Handled...Managed...Responsible for...

While these are good, you might want to switch them up throughout your resume. Use other words to show your well-rounded experience and great accomplishments. In the tables below, we have included: leadership competencies (shaded-box); accomplishments (2nd column); and verbs/power words (3rd column). Look for the competencies you demonstrate and find other suitable verbs to help make your resume great!
